In Collaboration with the Central Bank of Jordan, the Jordan Insurance Federation Organises Its Ninth Training Programme Entitled: "Information Security and Cybersecurity" As Part of Its 2025 Annual Training Plan

As part of its continued efforts to benefit from the expertise of local professionals in training personnel working in the Jordanian insurance market and in economic institutions intersecting with the insurance sector, the Jordan Insurance Federation (JIF) is pleased to host Mr. Ramadan Hasweh, from the Cybersecurity Operations Team at the Central Bank of Jordan, as the lead instructor for its upcoming specialised training programme entitled:

"Information Security and Cybersecurity",

which will be held over two days, from 30 to 31 July 2025, with a total of 12 training hours.

The training programme aims to familiarise participants with the concept of cybersecurity, while clarifying the difference between cybersecurity and information security. The sessions will cover cybersecurity policies, key security protocols such as VPN, SSL/TLS, and the fundamentals of cyber risk management, including identifying digital assets and evaluating their value.

The programme will also cover essential topics such as network and system protection, application and software security, and operational security. In addition, participants will be introduced to incident response protocols, cybersecurity-related laws and regulations, and a review of the latest trends in this critical field.

Mr. Ramadan Hasweh is a seasoned cybersecurity expert with an extensive professional background across the Internet Service Provider (ISP) sector, airports, and banking institutions. He holds a Bachelor's degree in Information Technology from the University of Jordan and has broad experience in information security management, penetration testing, security assessment, network security, and cloud computing. He has also played a key role in overseeing the financial and banking sector from a cybersecurity perspective, including compliance assessment, supervisory follow-up, and ensuring implementation of controls to mitigate cyber risks threatening this vital sector.

This training programme is part of JIF's 2025 Annual Training Plan, which aims to build the capacity of professionals working in the insurance sector, particularly information security officers at insurance companies, in addition to regulatory bodies, banks, financial institutions, and all stakeholders and professionals involved or interested in information security and cybersecurity.

To date, the programme has attracted a total of 29 participants, representing 14 local insurance companies, in addition to one participant from the Central Bank of Jordan, and five staff members from the Jordan Insurance Federation.
